

Club Mid '18 Information

Thanks for registering for Club Mid! Here are some things we're asking everyone coming to Club Mid to be aware of:

Daily Check-In and other Registration Notes

Students will be required to check in at the front entrance each day, regardless of pre-registration status. This gives us an accurate count of students per team each day. Students *not* registered are allowed to register in person any morning they are able to come.

Medication:

Any prescription medication must come with a note and be turned in to the staff at check-in each morning. Many medication needs can be self-managed by the students themselves (take what they need at home or take it on their own during the day) but our camp nurse will willingly facilitate medication while your students are with us if necessary or preferred.

Afternoon Rotations

Teams will have a different rotation each day immediately following lunch. Some will be off-campus but none of them will involve any extra costs to the student. A schedule of these rotations will be available each day at the check-in tables.

Additional Expenses:

Students do not require any extra money to get through the day. However, candy and soda are sold at our snack shack for 0.50¢.

Parent Release:

Students must have a parent release form on file signed by both the student and a parent. Being our first event of the school year, each student attending is required to fill out a form. This form is kept on file and is valid Camp Getaway (July 23-27) and all other Middle School events for the duration of the '18/'19 school year.

As with all our activities, we have a set of behavior standards (printed on the back of the parent release form) that all students must cooperate with. By signing the parent release form, you/your student agrees to abide by all standards set.
